The purpose of the Boundaries Session is to provide a safe, confidential environment to fellowship and learn to apply God's word in the area of codependency and enabling, and celebrate God's transforming power.

Codependency involves two people, one with an addictive or compulsive behavior, and the other one who is overly responsible and inadvertently enables the others behavior.

On the surface, codependency messages sound like Christian teaching. Beware of counterfeits! Codependency is nothing more than a counterfeit of what it means to be a Christian servant.

- Codependency burns out those who engage in it.
- Codependency enables the other person (the dependent) to remain unhealthy.
- Codependency gets in the way of God's work in the dependent's life.


Three main characteristics of enabling:

- 1. Warped sense of responsibility
- 2. Lack of objectivity
- False guilt

In Contrast, Christian servants:



- Are assertive; can state their feelings and what they want in a nice way.
- Know they are valuable because of what Christ did. not what they do.
- Balance meeting their own needs and recharging with serving others.
- Will martyr themselves if clearly lead by the Holy Spirit.
- Are interested in pleasing God above all, not others.

Codependency Messages:

- "Codependency always puts others first before taking care of ourselves. (Aren't Christians to put others first?)
- "Codependents give themselves away." (Shouldn't Christians do the same?)
- "Codependents martyr themselves." (Christianity honors its martyrs.)



Codependency: Enabling Versus Serving

Enabling Versus Serving; Six Distinctions

Enabling

- Motive: Rescue from (needed) consequences; maintain approval
- Power: Self; limited power so burn out.
- Means: Guided by human emotions, reasoning & intellect
- Self-Worth: Must be earned by pleasing others
- Focus: On other person; taking care of them & fixing their problems. On self; fear of being labeled selfish.
- Result: Both stay stuck, neither grow spiritually. Hurt & resentment.

♣ Serving

- To promote growth & responsibility; good steward
- God's; unlimited power, renewed strength, not weary
- Guided by the Holy Spirit through faith; infinite wisdom
- Based on identity in Christ and His unconditional love
- On Jesus, able to rest in Him and take His yoke
- Fruit of the Spirit; peace & joy. Both able to grow.
